Becky McKinney and Sam Scales both addressed the court with remaining concerns regarding the Sims Bark Mulch Facility located off of 431 South. Major complaints are smoke, noise and light pollution, noting that the noise pollution has seemed to be better in the last 7-10 days. Plant manager, Jamie Webster, addressed these concerns and mentioned that the noise reduction project was completed on May 30, 2026, which is why the plant is seemingly less noisy for neighbors.
