

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

This is a Request for Qualifications to provide engineering design and construction inspection services for Logan County. Logan County will be seeking funding from the Land & Water Conservation Fund and other sources to make improvements to create a new county recreational park.

The proposals are not to exceed 50 pages and shall be submitted as sealed proposals to the Logan County Fiscal Court at 200 W. 4th St., Russellville, KY, 42276 no later than 9:00 A.M. CST on December 10, 2024. The proposals will be publicly opened at the Logan County Fiscal Court meeting on December 10, 2024 at 9:00 A.M. CST. All submittals shall be clearly marked "Logan County Park Feasibility Study/Master Plan Proposal." Proposals received after the specified date and time will not be considered.

1. Letter of Transmittal
2. Description of Project Team
3. Description of firm's capabilities and experience in the preparation of Master Plans
4. Description of experience in and proposed strategy for public involvement and outreach
5. Proposed general project approach and timeline
6. Office location of firm's key personnel
7. Description of firm's ability to be responsive

The Contract will be awarded to the responsible firm whose proposal is determined to be the most advantageous to Logan County.
